Premier Kathleen Wynne will apologize to former Huronia residents in the legislature on Monday, December 9, 2013 at approximately 2 p.m.

- Former residents and their families as well as members of the general public can watch the apology and proceedings from the public galleries in the Chamber
- They will need to make arrangements and appropriate accommodations to visit the legislature
- To enter the galleries, they will need to obtain a gallery pass from the Special Constable stationed at the south basement entrance
- Passes to watch the apology in the Legislature are free, and are given out on site on a first-come, general admission seating basis
- The public galleries are equipped with closed captioning. Visitors using a wheelchair are seated in a wheelchair-accessible area in the Speaker's gallery
