

STAFFING REQUIRED: SUPPLY/CASUAL COMMUNITY LIVING WORKERS

The Community Living Worker is responsible for providing personal support to individuals with developmental disabilities to enable each to be a valued, contributing member of the community. Guided by the goals and objectives determined in collaboration and consultation with the individual and his/her support network, the Community Living Worker is responsible for supporting the development of skills and competencies that will assist each person to pursue and fulfil their goals and aspirations. The Community Living Worker will be required to assist the individual in work, community and home settings and will be responsible for liaising with a variety of community organizations to support those organizations in their efforts towards inclusion. Shift work is required.

The ideal candidate will possess:

- Two year community college diploma relating to the field of human services
- Experience working with, supporting and empowering individuals with intellectual disabilities
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to work independently, with minimal supervision and as a productive team member
- A steadfast belief and commitment to inclusion, the right for all people to belong, participate and contribute to the community
- Excellent coaching skills
- Ability to generate creative ideas
- Ability to find out about the local community and utilize social capital
- Commitment to Community Living's goal and vision
- Valid First Aid and CPR certification
- A car, \$2 million liability insurance and a valid driver's license
- Current criminal reference check including vulnerable sector screening
